




Officer Training and Mental Health

Professionalize Policing with National Standards

- National licensing to set a minimum bar
- Consistent measurement of performance
- Process to decertify unfit officers
- National police hiring exam for psychological, emotional, physical and intellectual fitness
- Standard and consistent training, including sensitivity training
- Mental health supports





Build Trust through **Transparency**

- Uniform use of bodyworn cameras
- Penalties for intentionally turning off
- Permanent and public national database of officer misconduct
- Uniform reporting standards



De-escalation and Citizen Mental Health





Reframe Role to Preserve Life

- Demilitarize policing
- Standard national definition of lethal force
- Restrict deadly restraints
- Mental health expert response
- Continuous training in de-escalation





Ensure Accountability

- Independent investigations and standard investigatory process
- National police shooting database
- National Police Accountability Oversight Task Force
- Removal of qualified immunity
